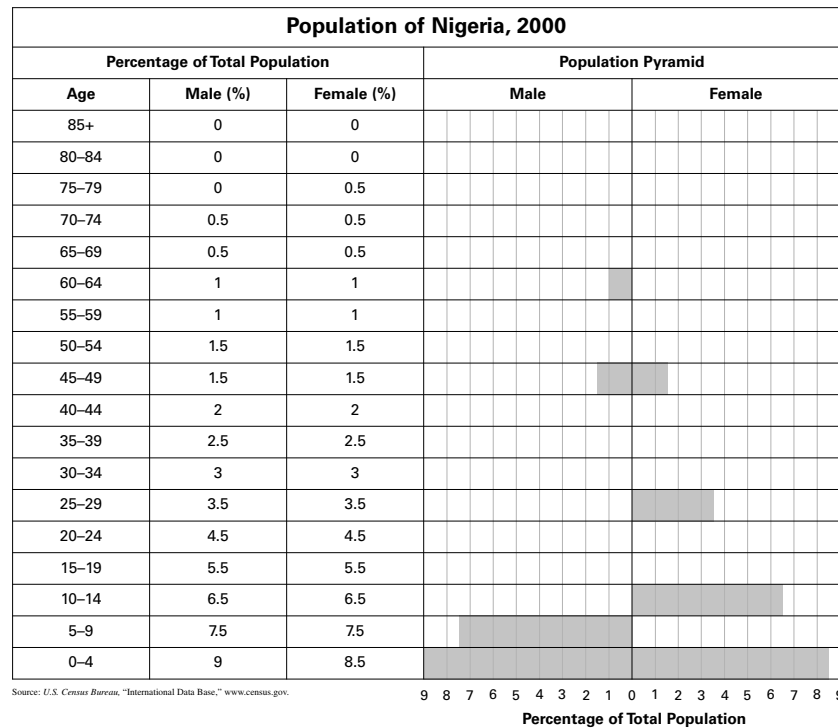


To create a population pyramid for Nigeria, follow these steps for each age band. Start with the “0–4 years” age band and work upward.

1. Locate the age band in the data table and on the pyramid grid.
2. If the age band is already drawn, color it in. Use blue for males on the left side. Use red for females on the right side.
3. If the age band is missing, complete it. Use blue to draw in the percent of the population that is male on the left. Use red to draw in the percent of the population that is female on the right.
